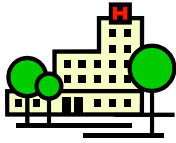


# FEBRUARY MISSIONS PROJECT

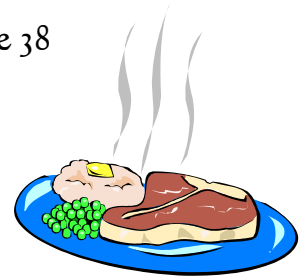
Sponsored by Women's Ministries

These comfort homes are built by the Fisher House Foundation, Inc. and given as gifts to the military services and the Department of Veterans Affairs. Within walking distance of the hospital the Fisher Houses are a comfortable temporary home, filled with warm, caring people who help family members endure the stresses associated with a loved one's serious medical condition. 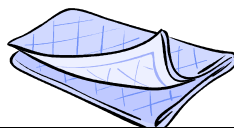
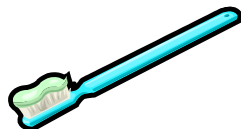
